NATURE OF POSITION

Collaborates in the practice of nursing using the nursing process within scope of practice as well as providing personal care and assistance in the activities of daily living to residents. Participates as a member of the interdisciplinary team in providing nursing care to residents. Works under the direct or indirect supervision of a registered nurse.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Graduate of an accredited course for Licensed Practical Nurses.
- 2. Active registration with the Association of New Brunswick Licensed Practical Nurses or eligible for active registration in New Brunswick.
- 3. Ability to work in a team setting and follow verbal and written instructions.
- 4. Knowledge of gerontology and experience in geriatrics preferred.
- 5. Physically and emotionally able to perform assigned duties.
- 6. Good work record
- 7. Professional personal appearance.

- C.5 Provides a comfortable, safe and clean environment for residents, volunteers and visitors.
