

The United Church Home for Senior Citizens, Inc. (Drew Nursing Home) is a non-profit organization that operates a 118-bed nursing home located in Tantramar (formerly Sackville), New Brunswick.

The Drew Nursing Home is governed by a community-based board of directors and we regularly seek individuals from the greater Tantramar and Moncton areas to fill vacancies on our dynamic Board of Directors.

Consider using your unique skills to display your commitment to the community and a sector that you care about. Help shape the future of the Drew Nursing Home while enhancing your leadership skills, meeting and working with interesting people and growing your network.

The Board's primary role is to provide strategic direction for the Home in consultation with the Executive Director in meeting its mission and vision of ensuring that the resident is the primary focus of all aspects of the operation of the Home. Directors also have the opportunity of deepening their understanding by serving on a sub-committee and they have the option of attending regional and/or provincial sector meetings.

The Board works closely with the Executive Director who has the day-to-day responsibility for the operation of the organization.

What experience are we looking for?

In selecting a candidate to serve as a Director on our 10 to 15 person Board, primary consideration is given to education and/or skills that will benefit the governance function of the Board. Such education or skills may include a background in board governance, business administration, finance, geriatric care, health care services, human resource management, legal services, plant operations and building management, and/or religious ministry. Being community minded or having lived experience would also be an asset.

What does the role entail?

A Director is elected for a three (3) year term. Regular meetings of the Board are held bi-monthly from September to June. Meetings are in the evenings with dinner provided.

The following is a brief summary of the responsibilities of the Board and the directors that serve on it.

- **Strategic Oversight:** Participating in setting the strategic direction and long term goals. This includes monitoring progress and making adjustments as necessary to ensure success of the Home.
- **Fiduciary Duty:** Acting in the best interest of the Home including ensuring prudent use of all assets, for the benefit of the residents, including the facility and its people in accordance with the skill level reasonably expected by a person of their background.
- **Legal and Ethical Compliance:** Ensuring the Home adheres to all applicable laws, regulations and ethical standards.
- **Policy Development and Governance:** Developing major policies for the Home that reflect the needs of the Home and the community it serves.
- **Executive Oversight and Support:** Selecting, evaluating and supporting the Executive Director.
- **Risk Management:** ensuring the Home has a program to identify, assess and manage risks that could impact the Home.
- **Participation and Engagemeny:** attending, preparing and participating knowledgeably in Board deliberations.
- **Continuous Learning:** Stay informed about sector trends, best practices in governance and emerging issues affecting the Home.
